As a participant of the 2009 summer youth mission trip with St. Timothy's youth group, I agree to live by and follow this community covenant during the entire time we are away.

I will not bring weapons of any kind with me, nor will I purchase them. This includes explosives, fireworks, or any other dangerous material.

I will not use tobacco, alcohol or any illegal substances

I will not engage in any physically romantic behavior (i.e. holding hands, kissing, etc...)

I will not leave the grounds nor the group without the express knowledge and consent of the group leader

I will be on time and be where I am supposed to be at all times

I will respect all other people and other people's property, including the property of TEAMEffort, Aurora United Methodist Church, and of my fellow participants

I will only use my cell phone, ipod, and other electronics during designated times.

I will not use offensive or hurtful language.

I will not go into the opposite gender's sleeping quarters

I will follow the dress code established by TEAMEffort and the leaders from St. Timothy's

By agreeing to this covenant I am committing myself to living in Christian community and fellowship with the other participants. I recognize that by covenanting together, all the participants from St. Timothy's on this trip have made a promise and contract with each other on how we will relate to each other.

By agreeing to this covenant with my fellow participants, I understand that there will be consequences if I break trust on this covenant. I know that any breach of this covenant will be dealt with and not ignored. I understand that if I do not live by this covenant, as a last resort, I may be asked by the Group Leader to leave and will be sent home at my own (or my parent's) expense.

God, give us the strength to live in a covenantal relationship with you at all times. Help us work together, live together, play together, and listen to each other during our time together. We ask that You, along with the Holy Spirit, and Jesus Christ our Lord, be always at the center of our community. Amen.
